## LONG

The Munich born soprano Julia Duscher is a sought-after soloist for music in the baroque and classical periods and gives concerts in concert halls such as the Isarphilharmonie Munich, Konzerthaus Bamberg, Herkulessaal Munich, Speyer Cathedral and with ensembles such as the "Munich Philharmonic", "Dresden Baroque Orchestra", "Munich Symphony Orchestra" or "L'arpa festante".

Recitals have taken her to renowned song festivals in Schloss Elmau, Pierre Boulez Saal Berlin, MelosLogos Weimar and the Heidelberger Frühling, as a duo with Gerold Huber among others. The soprano has also participated in a charity recital alongside Christian Gerhaher at the Gärtnerplatztheater in Munich. In 2021/22 she received a scholarship from the Heidelberg Lied Academy under the direction of Thomas Hampson where she started working with Graham Johnson and Hartmut Höll.

The young singer sang in a new production of "Jedermann" at the Salzburg Festival in 2021 and made guest appearances at the Staatstheater am Gärtnerplatz in Munich while she was still a student. She won the special prize for best interpretation of a contemporary piece at Bundeswettbewerb Gesang Berlin, second prize in the Gasteig Competition in Munich and was a finalist in the Bertelsmann Foundation's "Neue Stimmen" competition in 2022. She made her masters at the University of Music and Theater in Munich with Prof. Christiane Iven.

In the current season she will be making her debuts at the Teatro Comunale Modena and the Teatro Municipale Reggio-Emilia (IT) and will be a guest as a soprano at the DAVOS Festival 2023 with various baroque programs and Britten Illuminations.
